PARKVIEW MEDICAL CENTER'S NEW PUEBLO WEST ED CLINIC OPENS

Pueblo, CO – Almost a year to the date of breaking ground, Parkview Medical Center's new state-of-the-art Pueblo West Emergency Department opens. The new 18,000 SF standalone, emergency department, designed by H+L Architecture of Colorado Springs, Colorado, was constructed to accommodate the increased need for healthcare services in Pueblo West and neighboring communities along Highway 50 West.
